



TAMPNET TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. PROVISION OF SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT BY TAMPNET

1.1. These (i) Terms and Conditions, (ii) Customer's written acceptance of an Tampnet quotation, estimate or proposal (collectively referred to as "quotation"), and (iii) a Master Services Agreement, or similar, executed by and between Tampnet and Customer, when taken together, will govern the provision by Tampnet of Services and/or Equipment (collectively referred to as "**Network Services**") to Customer. There are no other oral or implied agreements, warranties or understandings, and from time to time, Tampnet may, at its sole discretion, add, delete or modify the portfolio of Network Services made available to Customer under these Terms and Conditions.

1.2. In the absence of a quotation signed by Customer, Customer's verbal instruction or issuance to Tampnet of a purchase order, work order, work ticket or other form of written order on Customer's standard form (collectively "**Purchase Order(s)**") will constitute Customer's acceptance of an Tampnet quotation. All future orders for Network Services will be governed by these Terms and Conditions, unless otherwise agreed. Future orders will be subject to Tampnet's acceptance, which may be withheld for any reason or for no reason. Customer's Purchase Order will be treated as an administrative document only and will not add to, delete from or change any of these Terms and Conditions.

1.3. Customer is responsible for notifying Tampnet, in writing, of any requirement to permanently deactivate or suspend Network Services. Permanent deactivation or suspension of Network Services will be effective only after Tampnet's receipt and written acknowledgement of Customer's written request. If applicable, and at Tampnet's sole discretion, Customer may be liable for early termination fees if Network Services are terminated prior to the contracted term (as defined in Section 12.5 below) of such Network Services. Furthermore, Customer may continue to be liable for payment of Network Services that are suspended by Customer, during the period of suspension, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Tampnet.

2. SERVICE SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS

2.1. **Private Line Microwave Communications.** Tampnet operates a broadband, digital, point-to-point, microwave network that serves locations in the Gulf of Mexico and onshore locations in Louisiana and Texas. Customer may rent private line circuits ("**Circuits**") on the network in accordance with the rates, terms, and conditions specified in the applicable quotation and these Terms and Conditions. A Circuit is a telecommunication channel between two different locations specified by the Customer that are dedicated exclusively to the Customer's use and configured to meet the needs of Customer, as mutually agreed upon by Tampnet and Customer. The bandwidth of the Circuit will be as stated on the quotation. The Circuits may be connected to jurisdictionally intrastate communications services or facilities, but no such services or facilities are provided under these Terms and Conditions. Circuits may be relocated from any given Customer location to another Customer location provided that Customer pays to Tampnet the reasonable cost to remove and install any associated Equipment at the new location.

2.2. **Tampnet Microwave Communication Services.** Tampnet's microwave communication service is a point-to-multipoint OFDM (Orthogonal Frequency Division Multiplexing) service, using licensed spectrum at the 3.65GHz band and technology that meets the WiMax standard (IEEE 802.16 standard). In no event will Tampnet be liable for any damages whatsoever, due to degradation or disruption of the service due to (i) obstructions in the line-of-sight between the Customer premise equipment (CPE) and Tampnet's base station(s), or (ii) unavailability, disruption or inability to provide the Service due to frequency interference by a third party.

2.3. Tampnet Satellite Communications Services.

2.3.1. Customer understands and acknowledges the following: (a) Tampnet does not own or operate its own satellite communication system, (b) Tampnet is a reseller of Network Services, and (c) Tampnet purchases



Network Services from third party suppliers (collectively the “**Satellite Supplier(s)**”), under strict contractual terms and conditions required of all resellers.

2.3.2. Services may be temporarily unavailable or limited because of capacity limitations, network equipment failures, distress or any other emergency pre-emption as required by Tampnet or a Satellite Supplier. Services may also be temporarily interrupted or curtailed due to modifications, upgrades, repairs or similar activities of Tampnet’s Satellite Supplier. The use and restoration of certain space segment is governed by Part 64, Subpart D of the FCC’s Rules and Regulations, which specify the priority system for such activities. Tampnet has no liability for any Satellite Supplier networks.

2.3.3. The obligations of Tampnet and the terms for the sale and provision of Network Services are subject to the terms of the agreements under which Tampnet purchases the Network Services from its Satellite Suppliers (each an “**Other Contract**”). To the extent fulfillment of any obligation of Tampnet under these Terms and Conditions is not permissible or possible under an Other Contract, the Other Contract will prevail and such obligation will be suspended or modified to the extent required by the Other Contract.

2.3.4. **Improper Illumination.** “**Improper Illumination**” is defined as any of the following: (a) transmissions other than as specified in writing by Tampnet, or (b) transmissions of an incorrect frequency, or (c) transmissions at excessive power levels, or (d) any illumination that could cause harm to or interference on any transponder or space segment on any satellite. If Tampnet detects or is informed of any Improper Illumination of any Service provided under these Terms and Conditions, Tampnet will immediately notify Customer. Customer will take immediate corrective action to stop the Improper Illumination. If capable, and as soon as capable, Tampnet will temporarily suspend, with no liability to Customer, any affected Services should Customer be unable to rectify the Improper Illumination within four (4) minutes from notification of the Improper Illumination to Customer as set forth in the preceding sentence. Such affected Services will be suspended until Customer demonstrates to Tampnet’s sole satisfaction that the Improper Illumination is rectified. Customer will be charged and will pay any amount that Tampnet is required to pay to its Satellite Suppliers or other telecommunications service provider(s) under any Other Contract due to any Improper Illumination attributable to Customer. Tampnet will timely inform Customer in writing of any liability Tampnet incurs as a result of such Improper Illumination. It is Customer’s responsibility to provide Tampnet, on or before the Due Date, with a telephone number(s) at which Tampnet can contact Customer twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week, 365/366 days per year. In addition, Tampnet has the right, in its sole discretion, to take immediate action, including but not limited to suspending or terminating any affected Service(s), in order to protect Tampnet’s services and/or interests.

2.3.5. **Tampnet satellite communications service is a contended service, for which a contention ratio is applicable. Customer will adhere to Tampnet’s fair access policy, a copy of which is available upon written request to Tampnet. Tampnet implements weight-based fair queuing algorithms to give all customers equal and fair access to network resources if no Customer specific QoS is implemented.**

2.4. **Terrestrial Services.**

2.4.1. Customer understands and acknowledges the following: (a) Tampnet does not own or operate its own terrestrial network, (b) Tampnet is a reseller of Network Services, and (c) Tampnet purchases Network Services from third party suppliers (collectively the “**Terrestrial Supplier(s)**”), under strict contractual terms and conditions required of all resellers.

2.4.2. The obligations of Tampnet and the terms for the sale and provision of terrestrial Network Services are subject to the terms of the agreements under which Tampnet purchases such terrestrial Network Services from its Terrestrial Suppliers (each an “**Other Contract**”). To the extent fulfillment of any obligation of Tampnet under these Terms and Conditions is not permissible or possible under an Other Contract, the Other Contract will prevail and such obligation will be suspended or modified to the extent required by the Other Contract. **TAMPNET MAKES NO WARRANTIES WHATSOEVER WITH RESPECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF TERRESTRIAL NETWORK SERVICES.**



EQUIPMENT

2.5. Purchased Equipment.

2.5.1. (i) Subject to Section 2.5.2 below, risk of loss in Equipment purchased by Customer will transfer upon delivery to Customer and delivery will take place when such Equipment is shipped by Tampnet. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, Tampnet will ship all Equipment EXW (Ex Works, Incoterms 2010) Tampnet's premises in the United States to Customer's designated location, and all shipping costs will be to Customer's account. In no event will Tampnet have any liability in connection with any shipment, nor will the carrier be deemed to be an agent of Tampnet. Unless otherwise agreed in a quotation, Customer agrees to accept partial shipments.

2.5.2. If Customer is unable to accept shipment/delivery of Equipment for any reason, Tampnet will store such Equipment, subject to availability of space and free of charge, for a period of thirty (30) days from notification to Customer that the Equipment is ready for shipment. If Customer is still unable to accept shipment/delivery of Equipment after the aforesaid thirty (30) day period, then Tampnet will charge Customer, and Customer will pay, a storage fee for such Equipment at a rate of One Hundred (\$100.00) United States Dollars, per month, for each 4 ft x 4 ft x 4 ft pallet space, or fraction thereof, required to store the Equipment. Customer will be solely responsible for risk of loss or damage in any Equipment stored by Tampnet pursuant to this clause.

2.5.3. Title to Equipment purchased by Customer will transfer from Tampnet to Customer upon Tampnet's receipt of the full sale price and any applicable taxes, fees, and freight charges. Until such time, Customer will keep Equipment that is owned by Tampnet free from any liens, claims or encumbrances.

2.5.4. Tampnet warrants that new Equipment delivered to Customer will perform substantially in accordance with the specifications contained in the technical documentation accompanying the Equipment for a period of one (1) year/(365 days) from the date of delivery. All refurbished or used Equipment or accessories sold hereunder will be free from defects in workmanship and material for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of delivery. All repairs covered by such warranty will be performed at no charge to Customer. For any repairs requested after the warranty period, Tampnet will provide a quotation for such repairs and if the quotation is accepted and the work authorized by Customer, the repairs will be performed at Customer's expense. In the event of a warranty claim, Tampnet will, at its sole option: (a) repair the Equipment so that it performs as set forth above, (b) replace the nonconforming Equipment with Equipment which performs as set forth above, or (c) if Tampnet determines that neither of the foregoing is commercially reasonable, upon return of the Equipment to Tampnet, refund all sums paid to Tampnet by Customer with respect to the nonconforming Equipment. The foregoing Equipment warranty is Customer's sole remedy in the event of a warranty claim, and is a 'back-to-base' warranty, such that Customer will bear the transportation cost of returning any nonconforming or defective Equipment to Tampnet's designated premises in the United States and also the transportation cost of returning the Equipment following a repair from Tampnet's premises in the United States to Customer's premises. If Customer requires a Tampnet technician to travel to Customer's location to perform warranty services, Customer is responsible for all costs associated with the travel including, but not limited to, transportation costs, living expenses, etc. Tampnet will provide Customer a written estimate of such costs upon request.

2.5.5. The foregoing warranty does not extend to Equipment which is altered, improperly installed by a third party or which fails or is damaged after delivery due to accident, act of God, shipment or handling, or due to storage, operation, use, or maintenance in a manner or environment which does not conform to the Equipment manufacturer's instructions or specifications provided by Tampnet at the time of delivery to Customer.

2.5.6. There will be no refunds for used Equipment returned to Tampnet. If Customer returns unused Equipment to Tampnet in its original package, in its original condition, and within thirty (30) days of delivery, Tampnet will refund to Customer seventy five percent (75%) of the purchase price, the remaining fifteen percent (25%) of the purchase price representing a restocking fee. Customer will bear all shipment and insurance costs related to such return shipment.



2.5.7. All Equipment returned to Tampnet must have an Tampnet-issued Returned Merchandise Authorization (“RMA”) number prominently displayed on the packaging and must be returned to the Tampnet facility as directed by Tampnet. An RMA number may be obtained by calling Tampnet’s Customer Care at (866) 621-5290 within North America (Toll Free) or by email at support@Tampnet.com. Equipment returned without an RMA number will be returned to Customer at Customer’s expense.

2.6. **Rental Equipment.** Tampnet will retain title to any and all Equipment that is rented to Customer. Unless otherwise agreed, all rental Equipment will be shipped FOB Tampnet’s premises in the United States to Customer’s designated premises. Risk of loss in the Equipment will transfer to the Customer upon delivery of the Equipment, and delivery will have deemed to take place when the Equipment is loaded onto the carrier’s vehicle. Customer agrees, at Customer’s sole expense, to (i) insure such Equipment against loss by fire, theft and any other casualty covered by standard fire and extended coverage insurance, for the full current replacement value, (ii) keep the Equipment free and clear from all adverse liens, security interests and encumbrances, (iii) provide a proper and suitable environment (including adequate power and appropriate temperature control) for the Equipment, in accordance with Tampnet and/or the manufacturer’s specifications (and any failure to provide such proper and suitable environment will void any warranty on the Equipment), (iv) keep the Equipment clearly labeled as property of Tampnet, in good order and repair and comply with any maintenance instructions given by Tampnet, (v) not transfer these Terms and Conditions, the Equipment or all or part of Customer’s interest therein, and (vi) return the Equipment to Tampnet at the end of the rental term in good condition, normal wear and tear excepted. Tampnet may charge Customer and Customer will pay Tampnet for the fair market value of the Equipment, in its reasonable determination, if Customer fails to return the Equipment to Tampnet within thirty (30) days of the end of the rental term. Breach by Customer of any of the foregoing provisions regarding rental Equipment will entitle Tampnet to enter Customer’s premises where the Equipment is reasonably believed to be located, and remove such Equipment without any legal process or notice, and without being liable for trespass or damage, and to declare all amounts remaining unpaid to be immediately due and payable by Customer.

2.7. **Floor Space, Conduit Access, and Electrical Power.** Customer must provide the following to Tampnet, at its own expense; the proper environment, lightning protection, crane (if necessary), space, electrical power, and telecommunications connections, equipment space, supporting structures, lighting, inside wiring, and unimpeded access to and egress from its premises required to install, operate, repair, maintain, inspect, re-provision, disconnect and remove any Equipment utilized in the provision of Services. Detailed installation requirements are set forth in Appendix A hereto. These provisions must be made available to Tampnet in sufficient time to permit the installation, maintenance or disconnection of any Equipment in accordance with the Due Date (as defined in Section 3 below). Tampnet’s obligations to perform installation, maintenance or disconnection will be amended accordingly if these conditions are not satisfied by Customer.

2.8. **Use of Customer Equipment.** Title to all equipment and facilities that Tampnet uses to provide the Network Services will remain with Tampnet. If Customer connects its own equipment to Tampnet’s network, Customer must ensure that such equipment is compatible with and does not harm, impair or interfere with the technical integrity of the Network Services, Tampnet’s network or its Suppliers network(s), or any other services or customers of Tampnet. Customer is responsible for the compatibility of its equipment with the network and failure to do so will constitute breach by Customer of these Terms and Conditions. Customer will provide and pay for all equipment and services required to connect Customer-provided equipment to the Services. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Customer may, subject to Tampnet’s consent, appoint Tampnet as its agent for purposes of procuring related telecommunications services, in particular, local exchange, backhaul, interexchange, or bypass carrier facilities (“**Facilities**”) to terminate Customer’s calls to Customer’s designated location. Customer will be responsible for payment for all such Facilities. Customer shall be liable and responsible for all actions and obligations incurred on its behalf by Tampnet in its capacity as Customer’s agent pursuant to this Section, and shall accept and pay Tampnet for all flow-through costs associated with such Facilities (or the termination of such services), including without limitation, all installation fees and monthly recurring fees, plus any applicable taxes. Customer acknowledges and agrees that Tampnet will have no liability or responsibility for



any Facilities. Any service level parameters and related warranties, pricing, surcharges, outage credits, required commitments, termination liability and other terms relating to the Facilities are those of the third party provider or carrier of such Facilities, and not Tampnet.

3. INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE

3.1. Tampnet and Customer will agree on a mutually convenient date for provision of the Network Services (“Due Date”). In the event the Due Date is delayed, Tampnet and Customer will agree upon a new Due Date. Customer will adhere to the Installation Guidelines set forth in Appendix A hereto. In no event will Tampnet be liable for failure to meet the Due Date when such failure is due to an act or omission by Customer. Customer will reimburse Tampnet for all out-of-pocket expenses incurred by Tampnet in relation to a failure to meet the Due Date caused by Customer. Customer’s sole remedy for a failure by Tampnet to either provide Services by the Due Date or to provide Services during the contracted term for such Services, will be for the Customer to request an Outage Credit, as defined in Section 5 below.

3.2. If stated on the quotation, and unless otherwise agreed, installation services will be provided by Tampnet or its subcontractors, on a time and materials basis at Tampnet’s then current rates for labor, or at the rates set forth in the applicable quotation.

3.3. If stated on the quotation, Tampnet will provide maintenance services in relation to the Network Services. On-site maintenance will be made available on a time and materials basis at Tampnet’s then current rates for labor, or at the rates set forth in the applicable quotation. Customer agrees to comply with all reasonable instructions that Tampnet may give, from time to time, and to provide all necessary assistance to Tampnet in diagnosing any Network Service faults.

3.4. Where required by law or regulations or at the request of Tampnet, Customer will install, maintain and/or pay reasonable expenses incurred by Tampnet to provide special facilities and protective apparatus at locations involving high voltage power and/or hazardous materials.

4. STAND-BY TIME

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these Terms and Conditions, and regardless of whether related to any warranty in these Terms and Conditions, under all circumstance Customer will bear the cost of: (a) all offshore and overseas transportation expenses related to the provision of Network Services, and (b) all Stand-By time incurred by Tampnet or its contractor personnel that is caused by or attributed to Customer, including without limitation, where caused by delays to or untimely cancellation of service calls. For the purposes of this Article, Stand-By time means the amount of hours, or portion thereof, incurred by Tampnet while waiting for (i) transport to and from an offshore location; or (ii) access to the Customer’s premises if required hereunder. Stand-by time incurred by Customer will be charged at Tampnet’s then current rates for labor.

5. OUTAGE CREDITS

5.1. Subject to Section below and unless otherwise stated in a quotation, a pro rata credit allowance (“**Outage Credit**”) will be given to Customer for the total Outage period(s) during any given consecutive twelve (12) month period, not including the period permitted under the service availability commitment (e.g. for a service availability commitment of 99.5% in any given twelve (12) month period, Outages totaling 0.5% would not be subject to an Outage Credit). An Outage is defined as follows; (i) for microwave Circuits, there is a complete loss of the ability to originate or receive voice or data communications for a continuous period of more than forty-eight (48) hours; or (ii) for fixed satellite services, there is a complete loss of the ability to originate or receive voice or data communications causing the service availability to fall below 99.5% in any twelve (12) month period.

5.2. For terrestrial (e.g. backhaul) services, Tampnet will pass through to the Customer the service availability that it receives from its suppliers, if any. In the event of failure or degradation of a terrestrial service, Tampnet



will pass through and credit Customer's account with a rebate equal to the rebate that Tampnet receives from its suppliers, if any.

5.3. An Outage Credit, if any, will be applied against the charges payable to Tampnet under these Terms and Conditions and will be expressly indicated on the final invoice to Customer of the calendar year in which Outage Credit applies, for the period of the Outage, or prorated portion thereof, after written request to Tampnet. No other liability may in any event attach to Tampnet on account of interruption or failure to provide Network Services. All Outage Credit(s) will be treated as liquidated damages and not as penalties. Outage Credit(s) do not apply to Outages, (i) caused by Force Majeure, (ii) caused by the negligence of Customer or others authorized by Customer when using Equipment related to the Network Services, (iii) caused by power failures or similar occurrences, such as perforation activity, not provided by or attributable to Tampnet, (iv) occurring during periods when Customer has elected not to allow for testing or repair, (v) caused by rain fade, solar outages or flares, extreme weather, or damage to satellites, or (vi) caused by the failure of equipment or facilities not provided by Tampnet.

6. SOFTWARE LICENSE

6.1. If applicable, upon installation of Equipment, Tampnet grants to Customer a fully paid, non-exclusive, non-sublicensable and non-transferable license and/or sublicense to use the software provided with the Equipment, including any third party software (the "Software"), for as long as Customer is entitled to use the Equipment. Customer may use the Software only in machine-readable, object code form. Third party software may be subject to additional terms and conditions described in the applicable third party software user documentation, and to the extent that those terms conflict with the terms of these Terms and Conditions, the third party terms will control. Customer may use the Software only for internal business purposes and only in connection with the Equipment. Customer may not assign, transfer, pledge, rent, share, copy or sublicense any of the Software. Customer further agrees not to reverse engineer, decompile or otherwise attempt to discover the source code of the Software.

6.2. If the Customer using the Equipment or Software is the U.S. Government, then the following restrictions apply:

6.2.1. The Software provided is software developed at private expense and is not in the public domain.

6.2.2. The Software is provided to non-Department of Defense government agencies with RESTRICTED RIGHTS and its supporting documentation is provided with LIMITED RIGHTS. Use, duplication, or disclosure by the Government is subject to the restrictions as set forth in subparagraph "C" of the Commercial Computer Software - Restricted Rights clause at FAR 52.227-19.

6.2.3. In the event the Software is provided to a Department of Defense government agency, the Government's rights in the Software, supporting documentation, and technical data are governed by the restrictions in the Technical Data Commercial Items clauses at DFARS 252.227-7015 and DFARS 227.7202.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Other than as specifically set forth in Section 6 above, no licenses or any rights of any kind under any patent, copyright and rights to create derivative works, trademark, trade secret, service mark, mask works or other form of intellectual property (collectively "**Intellectual Property Rights**") are granted by either Party or are to be implied by these Terms and Conditions or arisen by estoppel.

8. IMPLIED WARRANTIES

EXCEPT FOR THE EXPRESS WARRANTIES SET FORTH IN THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, ALL WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, WRITTEN OR ORAL, ARISING BY STATUTE OR OTHERWISE, IN RESPECT OF THE NETWORK SERVICES OR THE TAMPNET FACILITIES, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, WARRANTIES OF TITLE, NON-



INFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY, DURABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE ARE HEREBY DISCLAIMED.

9. USE OF NETWORK SERVICES

Customer will use the Network Services only in accordance with all applicable U.S. and foreign rules, laws and regulations. Customer will be liable for all use or misuse of the Network Services hereunder, irrespective of whether such use or misuse was authorized, fraudulent or otherwise. Customer will not resell or rent the Services or any rental Equipment. Customer will not use Network Services in an abusive or fraudulent manner, including, but not limited to the following:

- 9.1. accessing or attempting to access Network Services by using an unauthorized device or by tampering with or altering Equipment;
- 9.2. obtaining or attempting to obtain permission to use Network Services by providing false or misleading information;
- 9.3. obtaining Network Services without having the intent to pay charges incurred;
- 9.4. intentionally interfering with or causing disruption in the provision of Network Services to other Customers;
- 9.5. using Network Services to further criminal activity;
- 9.6. using Network Services to make obscene or illegal communications, to impersonate another person with fraudulent or malicious intent or to call another person so frequently or at such times of day or in any other manner with the intended effect of annoying, threatening or harassing such other persons; or
- 9.7. using Network Services in a manner that interferes unreasonably with the use of services or equipment by one or more other Tampnet customers.

10. PAYMENT TERMS

10.1. **Acceptance.** Billing for Services (or any part thereof) will commence upon the Acceptance Date for each network site, which is defined as follows: the earlier of (i) Customer's signature of the Acceptance Certificate or (ii) forty-eight (48) hours from installation of the Network Services, provided that Customer does not provide Tampnet with written notice that the Network Services fail to perform in accordance with the specifications in a material aspect, within the aforementioned 48-hour time period.

10.2. **Services.** Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the parties or stated in a quotation, Tampnet will invoice and Customer will pay, monthly in advance for the Network Services provided by Tampnet, including all applicable federal, state, provincial, local and other taxes, including value added tax and fees, including, if applicable, any fees established by a regulatory authority (including fees associated with the Universal Service Fund) for the provision of telecommunication services, which may be attributable to the sale or use of Network Services.

10.3. **Equipment.** Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the parties or stated in a quotation, invoices for Equipment will be sent on or after the date of shipment and will include all applicable federal, state, provincial, local, VAT and other taxes that may be levied upon the Equipment. Payment for rental Equipment is due monthly in arrears regardless of whether or not an invoice is sent to Customer by Tampnet.

10.4. In the event that any tax, duty, impost, levy or the like charge becomes payable in any territory in accordance with Sections 10.1 and 10.2 above, either by deduction or otherwise, on or in respect of any amount to be paid by Company to Tampnet, or which Company may be required to withhold in respect of any amount due to Tampnet, such tax, duty, impost levy or like charge shall be for the account of Company and Company shall pay to Tampnet such an amount as to yield to Tampnet a net equal to the amount that but for such tax, levy, impost or



charge would have been received by Tampnet. Tampnet will provide reasonable assistance to Company to minimize the amount of such withholdings or deductions, including providing any relevant certification of its status as a non-resident or a jurisdiction or of its entitlement to benefits under a treaty.

10.5. **Payment terms.**

10.5.1. Customer will pay all invoices within thirty (30) days of the receipt date of invoice, and in accordance with the instructions as stated on the invoice.

10.5.2. Amounts not paid within thirty (30) days of receipt invoice date will be subject to an interest charge of the lesser of, (i) one and one-half percent (0.5%) per month, or (ii) the highest rate permitted by law.

10.5.3. Customer will pay for any and all collection or litigation expenses, including reasonable legal fees, incurred by Tampnet in collecting any late payments or late payment fees.

10.6. Tampnet may require Customer to provide a third party guarantee, deposit, letter of credit, or other credit facility deemed by Tampnet, in its sole discretion, necessary to provide adequate assurance of payment. The provision of such third party guarantee, deposit, letter of credit, or other credit facility does not relieve Customer of its payment obligations specified herein.

10.7. All charges will be in accordance with the applicable quotation provided to Customer for the applicable Network Services. Upon expiration of the term of the Network Services (as stated in a quotation), Tampnet reserves the right to revise such charges upon notice to Customer.

10.8. Customer must pay all undisputed amounts when due. If any portion of an amount due is in dispute, Customer must, within thirty (30) days of the invoice date containing such disputed amount, give notice to Tampnet of the amount it disputes (“**Disputed Amount**”) and include in such notice the specific details and reasons for disputing each item. For the avoidance of doubt, claims of unauthorized use, fraudulent use or any other misuse will not constitute a valid basis for dispute of an invoice. If the Disputed Amount is resolved in favor of Tampnet, Customer must pay the Disputed Amount with appropriate late charges, if applicable, upon final determination of such dispute. Tampnet will issue credits to Customer upon resolution of any disputed amounts in favor of Customer. An invoice is deemed to be accepted if no written notice of a dispute is provided before the date the payment is due.

11. INDEMNITY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

11.1. DEFINITIONS.

11.1.1. THE TERM “TAMPNET GROUP” MEANS TAMPNET, ITS PARENT, SUBSIDIARY AND AFFILIATED COMPANIES, AND THE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, INSURERS, JOINT VENTURERS, CONSULTANTS AND AGENTS OF ALL OF THE FOREGOING.

11.1.2. THE TERM “CUSTOMER GROUP” MEANS CUSTOMER, ITS PARENT, SUBSIDIARY AND AFFILIATED COMPANIES, AND THE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, INSURERS, JOINT VENTURERS, CONSULTANTS AND AGENTS OF ALL OF THE FOREGOING.

11.2. EXCEPT FOR OUTAGE CREDITS AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 5 above THE PAYMENT OF DEFENSE AND INDEMNITY OBLIGATIONS UNDER SECTION 12.7, NEITHER PARTY NOR ANY OF ITS SUPPLIERS AND ITS RESPECTIVE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, INSURERS, SUBSIDIARIES AND AFFILIATED (INCLUDING PARENT) COMPANIES, AND THEIR EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES, OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS, WILL BE LIABLE ON ANY BASIS WHATSOEVER FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, RELIANCE, SPECIAL, PUNITIVE OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES (INCLUDING



BUT NOT LIMITED TO LOSS OF REVENUE OR PROFIT, LOSS ARISING FROM OR ATTRIBUTABLE TO FAILURE TO REALIZE ANTICIPATED SAVINGS, OR LOSS OF PRODUCTION, EQUIPMENT OR DATA) EVEN IF A PARTY KNEW OR HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OR LIKELIHOOD OF SUCH DAMAGES, IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROVISION OR FAILURE TO PROVIDE THE NETWORK SERVICES, FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER AND HOWSOEVER ARISING. TAMPNET'S LIABILITY IN CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE , INCLUDING ANY LIABILITY FOR NEGLIGENCE, HOWSOEVER ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF TAMPNET'S OBLIGATIONS UNDER THIS AGREEMENT WILL BE LIMITED TO THE REMEDIES PROVIDED HEREIN.

11.3. INJURY TO TAMPNET AND CUSTOMER AGENTS/EMPLOYEES; DAMAGE/DESTRUCTION TO TAMPNET AND CUSTOMER PROPERTY.

11.3.1. TO THE EXTENT OF TAMPNET'S NEGLIGENCE, TAMPNET WILL PROTECT, DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS CUSTOMER GROUP FROM AND AGAINST ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, CAUSES OF ACTIONS, LOSSES AND EXPENSES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES), OF EVERY TYPE AND CHARACTER, WITHOUT LIMIT AND WITHOUT REGARD TO THE CAUSE OR CAUSES THEREOF, ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED IN ANY WAY TO THE PROVISION OF THE NETWORK SERVICES, OR TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, WHICH ARE ASSERTED IN FAVOR OF TAMPNET GROUP, OR TAMPNET'S CONTRACTORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS, OR THE AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES (INCLUDING THE SPOUSES OR RELATIVES OF ANY SUCH AGENTS, EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES) OF TAMPNET GROUP, ITS CONTRACTORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS DUE TO PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH, OR DAMAGE, LOSS OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY (EXCLUDING ANY EQUIPMENT RENTED OR SOLD TO CUSTOMER BY TAMPNET), WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE JOINT AND/OR CONCURRENT NEGLIGENCE OF CUSTOMER GROUP. THE FOREGOING INDEMNITY WILL NOT APPLY TO PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH, OR DAMAGE, LOSS OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY CAUSED BY THE GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR WILFUL MISCONDUCT OF CUSTOMER GROUP.

11.3.2. TO THE EXTENT OF THE CUSTOMER'S NEGLIGENCE, CUSTOMER WILL PROTECT, DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS TAMPNET GROUP FROM AND AGAINST ALL CLAIMS, DEMANDS, CAUSES OF ACTIONS, LOSSES AND EXPENSES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES) OF EVERY TYPE AND CHARACTER, WITHOUT LIMIT AND WITHOUT REGARD TO THE CAUSE OR CAUSES THEREOF, ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED IN ANY WAY TO THE PROVISION OF THE NETWORK SERVICES, OR TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, WHICH ARE ASSERTED IN FAVOR OF CUSTOMER GROUP, OR CUSTOMER'S CONTRACTORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS, OR THE AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTATIVES (INCLUDING THE SPOUSES OR RELATIVES OF ANY SUCH AGENTS, EMPLOYEES OR REPRESENTATIVES) OF CUSTOMER GROUP, ITS CONTRACTORS OR SUBCONTRACTORS DUE TO PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH, OR DAMAGE, LOSS OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY, WHETHER OR NOT CAUSED BY THE JOINT AND/OR CONCURRENT NEGLIGENCE OF TAMPNET GROUP. THE FOREGOING INDEMNITY WILL NOT APPLY TO PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH, OR DAMAGE, LOSS OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY CAUSED BY THE GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR WILFUL MISCONDUCT OF TAMPNET GROUP.

11.4. EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, TAMPNET AND CUSTOMER WILL PROTECT, DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OTHER FROM ALL THIRD PARTY CLAIMS, DEMANDS, CAUSES OF ACTION, LOSSES AND EXPENSES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES) OF EVERY TYPE AND CHARACTER FOR PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH OR LOSS OF OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, INCLUDING DAMAGE TO THE ENVIRONMENT,



RESULTING FROM THE INDEMNITOR'S NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT. WHERE SUCH THIRD PARTY'S PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH OR LOSS OF OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY RESULTS FROM THE JOINT NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OF THE PARTIES, THE INDEMNITOR'S DUTY OF INDEMNIFICATION WILL BE IN PROPORTION TO ITS ALLOCABLE SHARE OF JOINT NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT. IF EITHER PARTY IS HELD STRICTLY LIABLE UNDER ANY APPLICABLE LAW, THE OTHER PARTY'S DUTY OF INDEMNIFICATION WILL BE IN THE SAME PROPORTION THAT ITS NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT CONTRIBUTED TO THE THIRD PARTY'S PERSONAL INJURY, DEATH OR LOSS OF OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY. FOR THE AVOIDANCE OF DOUBT, WHERE TAMPNET IS THE INDEMNITOR, THE INDEMNITEE IS CUSTOMER GROUP, AND WHERE CUSTOMER IS THE INDEMNITOR, THE INDEMNITEE IS TAMPNET GROUP.

11.5. CUSTOMER AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND DEFEND AND HOLD HARMLESS TAMPNET AND ITS AFFILIATES, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, ASSIGNS AND SUPPLIERS FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, CLAIMS, ACTIONS, LOSSES, DAMAGES (INCLUDING DAMAGE TO PROPERTY AND PERSONAL INJURY) AND EXPENSES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES) ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO (I) CUSTOMER'S MISUSE OF THE NETWORK SERVICES, AND/OR (II) ANY CLAIMS OR ACTIONS FOR LIBEL, DEFAMATION, SLANDER OR TRADEMARK OR COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT BASED ON THE CONTENT TRANSMITTED BY CUSTOMER IN CONNECTION WITH THE USE OR MISUSE OF THE NETWORK SERVICES, AND/OR (III) ANY CLAIM OR ACTION FOR PATENT INFRINGEMENT RESULTING FROM CUSTOMER'S USE (OR USE BY ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES, OR USE OF BY ANY OF ITS AFFILIATES, AGENTS, SUBCONTRACTORS, EMPLOYEES, ASSIGNS OR OTHERWISE) OF THE NETWORK SERVICES IN COMBINATION WITH THE EQUIPMENT, HARDWARE, SOFTWARE, SYSTEMS, CABLING, FACILITIES OR SERVICES NOT REASONABLY INTENDED HEREUNDER BY TAMPNET.

11.6. EXCEPT FOR ANY INDEMNITY OBLIGATIONS OR A BREACH THEREOF, THE TOTAL, AGGREGATE LIABILITY OF TAMPNET TO CUSTOMER FOR ANY AND ALL CLAIMS WHATSOEVER RELATED TO THE NETWORK SERVICES OR THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR DAMAGES TO CUSTOMER (OR TO ANY AFFILIATE OF CUSTOMER) FOR ANY CLAIMS WHATSOEVER, REGARDLESS OF THE FORM OF ACTION, WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), OR OTHERWISE, HOWSOEVER ARISING SHALL BE LIMITED TO DAMAGES ACTUALLY PROVEN AS DIRECTLY ATTRIBUTABLE TO TAMPNET, AND FURTHER LIMITED TO AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE LAST THREE (3) MONTHS OF PAYMENTS MADE BY CUSTOMER TO TAMPNET UNDER THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS PRECEDING THE DATE OF ANY CLAIM MADE AGAINST TAMPNET.

11.7. TAMPNET HEREBY AGREES TO HOLD CUSTOMER, ITS AFFILIATES AND THEIR DIRECTORS, OFFICERS AND AGENTS ("INDEMNITEES") FREE AND HARMLESS FROM ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, OR INJURY, TO DEFEND AT ITS OWN EXPENSE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, SUITS OR ACTIONS, AND TO PAY ANY JUDGMENTS AGAINST INDEMNITEES, ARISING OUT OF ALLEGED OR ACTUAL INFRINGEMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS OR COPYRIGHTS OR OTHER INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS OF ANY THIRD PARTY OR ALLEGED MISUSE OF TRADE SECRET INFORMATION, BY THE WHOLE OR ANY PORTION OF THE NETWORK SERVICES PROVIDED HEREUNDER OR ARISING DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY FROM TAMPNET'S PERFORMANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT. A PARTY RECEIVING A CLAIM OR NOTICE OF A POSSIBLE CLAIM AGREES TO NOTIFY THE OTHER PARTY, AS SOON AS IT IS REASONABLY POSSIBLE TO DO SO, OF SUCH A CLAIM. CUSTOMER RETAINS THE RIGHT TO PROVIDE ITS OWN ATTORNEY. IN THE EVENT THAT LEGAL PROCEEDINGS BASED ON COPYRIGHT OR PATENT OR TRADE SECRET OR OTHER INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY



INFRINGEMENT ARE BROUGHT AGAINST INDEMNITEES FOR ITS/THEIR USE OF THE NETWORK SERVICES, TAMPNET WILL, WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS, AT ITS EXPENSE, EITHER PROCURE FOR CUSTOMER THE RIGHT TO CONTINUE USING SUCH INFRINGING ITEM, OR REPLACE OR MODIFY THE INFRINGING ITEM(S) SO THAT IT BECOMES NON-INFRINGING WHILE CONTINUING TO FULFILL CUSTOMER'S REQUIREMENTS. IN THE EVENT THAT NEITHER OF THE IMMEDIATELY FOREGOING REMEDIES IS REASONABLE, THEN TAMPNET WILL GRANT TO CUSTOMER A REFUND FOR ALL FEES PAID FOR SUCH NETWORK SERVICES WHICH BECOMES UNUSABLE TO CUSTOMER.

12. TERMINATION

12.1. The occurrence or happening of any one or more of the following events will constitute an event of default if not remedied within ten (30) days after notice from Tampnet:

12.1.1. use of the Network Services in any manner or for any purpose contrary to law (see Section 9);

12.1.2. abuse or fraudulent use of the Network Services (see Section 9);

12.1.3. failure to make any payments when due;

12.1.4. discovery by Tampnet that any representation or warranty made by Customer in any document furnished by Customer to Tampnet is incorrect;

12.1.5. material breach or violation of any of these Terms and Conditions by the Customer; or

12.1.6. commencement of any proceeding, whether voluntarily or involuntarily, relating to the Customer under any law relating to insolvency, bankruptcy or the protection of creditors' rights generally.

12.2. Subject to Section 9, in the event of default, Tampnet may, at Tampnet's sole option and without in any way limiting any other rights and remedies it may have, suspend or terminate the Network Services without further notice. Tampnet will bill Customer and Customer will pay Tampnet, in accordance with Section 10, for all outstanding charges accrued up to and outstanding on the date of such termination. In all such cases, Tampnet will incur no liability whatsoever. Customer will be liable for all costs and expenses incurred by Tampnet due to default by a Customer, including but not limited to legal costs.

12.3. IN THE EVENT THAT TAMPNET TERMINATES THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND THE NETWORK SERVICES FOR A FAILURE TO PAY OR ANY OTHER MATERIAL BREACH, CUSTOMER AGREES TO PAY TAMPNET IMMEDIATELY A TERMINATION FEE, AS LIQUIDATED DAMAGES AND NOT AS A PENALTY, EQUAL TO THE NUMBER OF MONTHS REMAINING IN THE TERM TIMES THE AVERAGE MONTHLY CHARGE PRIOR TO TERMINATION. CUSTOMER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE PRECISE AMOUNT OF TAMPNET'S DAMAGES WOULD BE EXTREMELY DIFFICULT TO CALCULATE AND THAT SUCH PAYMENT REPRESENTS A REASONABLE ESTIMATE OF TAMPNET'S ACTUAL DAMAGES.

12.4. Tampnet may, with no liability whatsoever, suspend or terminate Network Services to Customer if lawfully ordered to cease operation of such Network Services by the Federal Communications Commission, a state or federal court of law, or any other lawful federal, state or local governmental authority. If at any time during the term of these Terms and Conditions any equipment, facilities, or property used by Tampnet to provide Network Services to Customer are taken for a public or quasi-public purpose by a lawful power or authority under the exercise of right of condemnation or eminent domain, Tampnet will have the right, upon written notice to Customer, to terminate Network Services affected by the taking.

12.5. **Early Termination.** Unless otherwise stated on the quotation, the minimum term of Service and rental of any Equipment is twelve (12) months from the Acceptance Date. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Customer may terminate early at any time, upon thirty (30) days notice to Tampnet. HOWEVER, IF CUSTOMER DOES SO



TERMINATE EARLY, CUSTOMER WILL PAY TO TAMPNET IMMEDIATELY AN EARLY FOR CONVENIENCE TERMINATION FEE, AS LIQUIDATED DAMAGES AND NOT AS A PENALTY, EQUAL TO THE BALANCE OF THE REMAINING TERM MULTIPLIED BY THE MONTHLY FEE FOR THE SERVICES AND ANY RENTAL EQUIPMENT. CUSTOMER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE PRECISE AMOUNT OF TAMPNET'S DAMAGES WOULD BE EXTREMELY DIFFICULT TO CALCULATE AND THAT SUCH PAYMENT REPRESENTS A REASONABLE ESTIMATE OF TAMPNET'S ACTUAL DAMAGES.

12.6. **Cancellation Prior to Service Activation.** Customer may, at any time up until ninety (90) days before the Due Date (as defined in Section 3.1 above), cancel the requested Network Services by providing notice to Tampnet in writing. If Customer does so cancel, Customer shall reimburse Tampnet for all out-of-pocket expenses incurred by Tampnet (including any penalties imposed on Tampnet by its suppliers) at cost plus fifteen percent (15%).

12.7. **Cancellation; Suspension of Network Services.** Customer is responsible for notifying Tampnet, in writing, of any requirement to permanently deactivate or suspend Network Services. Permanent deactivation or suspension of Network Services will be effective only after Tampnet's receipt and written acknowledgement of Customer's written request. Customer may send such request to support@Tampnet.us or by facsimile to +1 (337) 205-8761. Tampnet will use reasonable endeavors to respond to Customer's written request within one (1) business day. Customer is hereby notified that Tampnet will only process requests received from an authorized representative of the account holder/registered holder of the Equipment. If applicable, Customer may be liable to pay an early termination fee if Network Services are terminated prior to the contracted term (as defined in Section 12.5 above) of such Network Services. Furthermore, Customer will continue to be liable for payment of Network Services during any period of suspension, unless otherwise agreed in writing by Tampnet.

12.8. The rights of termination, restriction or suspension set forth in this Section are in addition to any other remedies available to Tampnet under these Terms and Conditions, or at law or in equity.

12.9. **Month-to-Month and Indefinite Services.** Any services provided by Tampnet on a month-to-month basis or for any other indefinite term require a minimum of thirty (30) days written notice by Customer to Tampnet prior to termination of services. No request to terminate service shall be effective until the end of such thirty-day period following such notice.

12.10. Customer may terminate this Agreement without obligation to pay a termination fee for material breach of these Terms and Conditions if the material breach is not remedied within thirty (30) days after written notice from Customer.

13. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

13.1. These Terms and Conditions do not create any partnership, joint venture, agency or employee/employer relationship of any kind between Tampnet and Customer. Tampnet is an independent contractor with respect to performance under these Terms and Conditions; all persons employed by each party are, and will remain, the employees and agents of that party and are not, and will not become, the employees or agents of the other party. It is expressly understood that neither party's employees may participate in or receive any benefits from the other party's employee benefit plans.

13.2. Limited for the purposes of the Louisiana Worker's Compensation Act and in order to comply with Louisiana Revised Statute 23:1061 where said Act and provisions may be applicable to the operations of Tampnet, Customer and Tampnet acknowledge and agree that the Network Services under these Terms and Conditions and any quotation are an essential part of Customer's trade, business or occupation and are an integral part of or essential to the ability of Customer to generate services and therefore Customer will be considered the statutory employer of the employees of Tampnet and any contractor and subcontractor of Tampnet.



14. CONFIDENTIALITY

14.1. Unless Customer consents in writing, or disclosure is made pursuant to a legal proceeding, Tampnet shall keep confidential all information or data furnished by Customer or otherwise acquired by Tampnet through performance. Such information will not be released by Tampnet to anyone other than: (i) Customer; (ii) a person who in the reasonable judgment of Tampnet is acting as an agent of Customer; (iii) to the commissioning entity or supplier or another telecommunications service provider provided that the information is to be used for the provision of Services and disclosure is made on a confidential basis with the information to be used solely for that purpose; (iv) an agent retained by Tampnet to collect outstanding balances owed to Tampnet by Customer; or (v) to a law enforcement agency whenever Tampnet has reasonable grounds to believe that Customer has knowingly supplied Tampnet with false or misleading information or is otherwise involved in unlawful activities.

14.2. Each party will comply fully with all applicable privacy and data protection laws and regulations, and will provide such assistance to the other party as is reasonably necessary to assist the other party in complying with such laws and regulations. Customer will indemnify Tampnet against claims by third parties resulting from breach or inadequate observance by Customer of the provisions of this Section 14.2.

15. FORCE MAJEURE

15.1. Tampnet will not be liable for any failure of performance hereunder due to causes beyond its reasonable control (“**Force Majeure**”), including without limitation, acts of God, strikes, lockouts or other labor disputes, acts of public enemy, governmental orders, preemption of existing services to restore service in compliance with Part 64, Subpart D, of the Federal Communications Commission’s Rules and Regulations, wars, riots, terrorist activities, epidemics, unusually severe weather, earthquakes, fires, floods, civil disturbances, explosions, train derailments, failure of or accidents to machinery, pipeline, or materials, and delay in delivery of Equipment, to the extent all such occurrences are beyond the reasonable control of Tampnet or Customer, delay in performance by subcontractors to the extent such delay is beyond Tampnet’s reasonable control, and other delays incurred for reasons beyond Tampnet’s reasonable control, which, by the exercise of reasonable diligence, they are unable to prevent or avoid. Tampnet’s obligation to perform will be suspended for the duration of a period of Force Majeure and will resume as soon as reasonably possible, upon the cessation of the event of Force Majeure.

16. NOTICES

All notices, requests, demands and other communications hereunder will be effective upon delivery. Such notices will be in writing and will be sent by email, facsimile or nationally recognized overnight courier or delivered in person, addressed as set forth below. Tampnet may, at any time, amend the above addresses for notices upon written notice to Customer.

If to Customer: To the address as set forth on the quotation, estimate or proposal executed by Customer.

17. ASSIGNMENT

Tampnet may, without the consent of Customer, (a) assign its right to receive payment hereunder to a third party, or (b) assign its rights and obligations hereunder to a corporation, partnership or other business enterprise in which Tampnet has directly or indirectly, an ownership interest, or (c) assign its rights to a successor in the event



of a merger, acquisition or consolidation, or to a purchase of all (or substantially all) of Tampnet's assets. These Terms and Conditions will inure to the benefit of, and will be binding on Customer's and Tampnet's respective successors and permitted assigns.

18. WAIVER OF COMPLIANCE

18.1. The waiver or the failure of Tampnet to enforce any of the provisions of these Terms and Conditions or to exercise any right or privilege hereunder, will not be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach or default of a similar nature, or as a waiver of any provisions, rights or privileges hereunder.

19. GOVERNING LAW / RULES & REGULATIONS

19.1. THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WILL BE GOVERNED AND CONSTRUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE GENERAL MARITIME LAW OF THE UNITED STATES, EXCLUDING ANY CHOICE OF LAW RULE THEREOF THAT WOULD DIRECT THE APPLICATION OF THE LAWS OF ANOTHER JURISDICTION. IN THE EVENT THAT THE GENERAL MARITIME LAW OF THE UNITED STATES IS DETERMINED BY A COURT NOT TO BE APPLICABLE, THEN THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS WILL BE GOVERNED AND CONSTRUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF LOUISIANA, USA EXCLUDING ANY CHOICE OF LAW RULE THEREOF THAT WOULD DIRECT THE APPLICATION OF THE LAWS OF ANOTHER JURISDICTION.

19.2. Both Tampnet and Customer will fully abide by all applicable laws, rules and regulations, including but not limited to all applicable anti-bribery or anti-corruption laws. Tampnet will not pay any commissions, fees or grant any rebates to any employee or officer of Customer, nor favor any employee or officer of Customer with gifts or entertainment of other than nominal value, nor enter into business arrangements with any employee or officer of Customer, other than as a representative of Customer, without the prior written approval of Customer.

19.3. Customer agrees to strictly adhere to the requirements and restrictions of the U.S. export and embargo laws and regulations, and any similar laws and regulations of other countries as applicable, in respect of the Network Services. Customer agrees to obtain, at Customer's sole expense, all necessary licenses, approvals, permits, consents and governmental authorizations that may be required for Customer's use of the Network Services. Customer may only use the Network Services in the region or with the satellite identified on the quotation. Customer may acquire the right to use the Network Services in other regions from Tampnet; however, an additional fee for reconfiguration of the Equipment and/or a different price for the Services may apply.

19.4. Tampnet will not be held responsible for any operational restrictions, customs, license or permit fees required for operation of the Network Services in the destination country. In addition, Tampnet will have no responsibility for fines associated with terminal seizure nor for legal ramifications of using Network Services in countries where it is prohibited. Customers are advised to contact the embassy or trade office of the destination country prior to entry into that country.

20. SEVERABILITY

21. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions will be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable by a court or regulatory agency of competent jurisdiction, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions will not in any way be affected or impaired thereby. In the event that any such provision will be declared invalid, illegal or unenforceable due to its scope, breadth or duration, then it will be modified to the scope, breadth or duration **PERMITTED** by law and will continue to be fully enforceable as so modified.

22. SURVIVABILITY

All provisions which would naturally survive the expiration or termination of these Terms and Conditions will so survive, including but not limited to the Articles entitled "Services Specific Terms and Conditions", "Equipment", "Use of Network Services", "Payment Terms", "Indemnity & Limitation of Liability", "Termination", "Confidentiality", and "Governing Law" and "Rules and Regulations".



23. RESTRICTED DESTINATIONS

No Services shall be used in, or Equipment imported into, any country where doing so is a violation of applicable U.S. law, and no Services shall be used by, or Equipment transferred to, any person or entity identified on the U.S. Specially Designated Nationals (SDN) List. Without limiting the foregoing, in no instance shall Services be used in, or Equipment imported into, the following countries without the express written consent of Tampnet, which will only be provided upon a showing that the proposed use or importation is licensed or otherwise authorized by the applicable authority: Cuba, Iran, Syria, Sudan and North Korea.

24. EFFECTIVE DATE

These Terms and Conditions are effective as of August 1, 2014, and will remain in effect unless modified, revoked or terminated by Tampnet.

25. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

Conflicts of interest relating to this Agreement are strictly prohibited. Except as otherwise expressly provided herein, neither, Tampnet nor any director, employee, or agent of Tampnet or its subcontractors or vendors shall give to or receive from any director, employee, or agent of Customer any gift, entertainment, or other favor of significant value, or any commission, fee, or rebate. Likewise, neither Tampnet nor any director, employee, or agent of Tampnet or its subcontractors or vendors shall, without prior written notification thereof to Customer, enter into any business relationship with any director, employee, or agent of Customer or any affiliate, unless such Person is acting for and on behalf of Customer. Tampnet shall promptly notify Customer of any violation of this Section and any consideration received as a result of such violation shall be paid over or credited to Customer. Additionally, in the event of any violation of this Section, including any violation occurring prior to the date of this Agreement, resulting directly or indirectly in Customer's consent to enter into this Agreement, Customer may, at Customer's sole option, terminate this Agreement at any time and notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, pay Tampnet only for that part of the Services performed prior to the date of termination. Any representatives authorized by Customer may audit any and all records of Tampnet and its subcontractors and vendors for the sole purpose of determining whether there has been compliance with this Conflicts of Interest Section.

26. AUDIT

Tampnet and its subcontractors and vendors shall maintain true and complete records in connection with the Services to be performed under this Agreement and all transactions related thereto and shall retain all such records for at least twenty-four (24) months after the end of the calendar year in which the Services are performed or transactions occur. Customer may from time to time and at any time during the foregoing period of record retention, make an audit of all records of Tampnet and its subcontractors and vendors pertaining to the Services.

APPENDIX A

Installation Guidelines

Scope

These installation guidelines set forth the obligations of Customer with respect to installation of Equipment. Unless otherwise agreed to in a quotation, Customer is responsible for meeting the requirements of these guidelines, at its sole expense.

Construction and Position of the Antenna

Customer is responsible for ensuring that the antenna has a clear and unrestricted view of the applicable satellite, at all times. Customer shall follow Tampnet’s reasonable instructions with respect to positioning of the antenna. Antennas should not be installed near traffic ways. Customer warrants that it will supervise all third party personnel requiring access to the antenna or the area surrounding it. In no event will Tampnet be liable damage to the antenna or failure of Network Services due to acts or omissions of third parties, or for any resulting health defects which may be incurred through such third party’s proximity to the antenna.

Installation Requirements

Customer shall ensure that Tampnet has free and unimpeded access to and egress from the installation site subject to Tampnet abiding by Customer’s policies relating safety, security, environment, drug, alcohol and search at Customer’s facilities. Customer shall obtain all necessary permits, consents and authorizations (“**Authorizations**”) necessary for the placement of the antenna. Authorizations shall include but not be limited to consent from the building owner, licenses associated with use of the Equipment and any governmental consents or permits. The antenna shall be installed on a level surface. If roof installation is required, such requirements will be set forth in the site survey. Unless otherwise agreed to in a quotation, Customer shall provide all equipment necessary for the installation. This may include, without limitation, use of a crane, scaffolding or hydraulic lifts. Customer shall ensure that there is sufficient space for the antenna. The following table sets forth the area around the antenna, which must be kept free from all other objects, in order to ensure safe and proper operation of the antenna.

Customer shall make available to Tampnet all technical description and other information required by Tampnet relating to the construction of the antenna foundation. Tampnet shall provide to Customer general static information for the antenna foundation. Customer shall construct the antenna foundation according to Tampnet’s specifications, at its sole expense. Customer is solely responsible for ensuring that the antenna foundation meets the requirements of any applicable law, rule, regulation, permit or Approval.

Laying of Cables

Customer is solely responsible for the laying of any required 1F cables and power cables. The distance between the antenna and the internal equipment shall not exceed 150m. Cables should not be laid parallel to existing power lines, and should be protected against damage by vehicles, construction work, persons, etc.

Safety Requirements

Tampnet will perform all installations in accordance with all applicable health and safety laws, rules and regulations and all applicable safety, health, environmental and security policies of Customer. Customer shall also comply with all applicable health, safety and environmental laws, rules and regulations.

Environmental Requirements

The following table contains the environmental requirements for Equipment. To the extent that there is any conflict between the following table and the specifications set forth in the manufacturer’s installation and/or operation guides, the manufacturer’s documentation shall take precedence. Customer will ensure compliance



with these requirements. Tampnet shall not be responsible for any damage or failure of Equipment due to Customer's failure to comply with such requirements.

Electric Power Supply

Customer shall provide, at its sole expense, an uninterruptible power supply of 230 V / 16A / 50Hz or 120 V / 20A / 60 Hz, depending upon the country, for installation and maintenance. If Customer does not provide power on an uninterruptible basis, then Customer shall be liable for any and all damages arising thereby.

If stated on a quotation, Tampnet may provide an uninterruptible power supply, subject to availability. If Tampnet does so provide such power, then Tampnet will invoice Customer and Customer will pay for all costs associated therewith. Specifications for any power that Tampnet may supply will be as follows, and as applicable depending upon the country where the installation is to be performed:

Input voltage (alternating current):	220 – 240 V 115 – 125 V
Fluctuating range input voltage (alternating current):	190 – 250 V 115 – 125 V
Input frequency range:	50 Hz +/- 10% 60 Hz +/- 10%

Customer shall ensure that any electricity supply is shut down upon request by Tampnet at any time, to the extent that it is necessary to avoid damage or interference to the Network Services. Customer shall provide the contact details of Customer's designated representative who has the authority to shut down electricity.

Lightning Protection

If there is no lightning protection system at the installation site, or if an existing lightning protection system is more than 5m from the antenna location, then Customer shall arrange for the antenna and any other ancillary equipment to be connected to an appropriate lightning protection system and ground. Customer shall comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations. Customer shall further ensure that the IDU has a potential equalization location with a response resistance of ≤ 2 Ohm. Customer shall also provide a cable trunk for the connection between the antenna and internal Equipment. The maximum distance for the lightning/grounding protection system is 5m for both the antenna and the internal Equipment. Cable specification should be Cu / Fe / Ø 10mm.

Fuses

Customer shall provide fuses in accordance with the following specifications:

For internal Equipment	230 V-	16 A	As separate circuits with safety sockets
For antenna heating (if applicable)	230 V-	10A	As separate circuits with grounding
If antenna AC is used	230 V-	10A	As separate circuits with grounding



Services Not Included in Standard Installation

In addition to the other provisions of this Appendix A, the following are not included in the standard installation. If Customer requests Tampnet to provide any of the following, then Tampnet will issue a separate quotation for such services.

- Any preliminary work
- Laying of cable lines
- Construction work, e.g. laying of foundation
- Fencing of the antenna unit
- Assembly of lightning protection
- Use and operation of a crane
- Disassembly of any existing equipment
- Packaging and crating of any removed/de-installed equipment
- Any labor associated with the foregoing
